

How to make a wormery!

What you need:

Clear Plastic Bottle



Soil



Sand



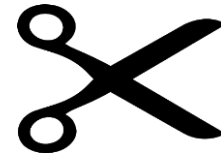
Compost



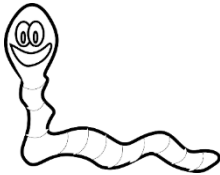
Paper



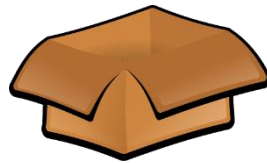
Scissors



Worms



Shoebbox



Method

1. Cut off the top part of the bottle using a scissors
2. Gently put in a layer of soil into the bottle
3. Add a layer of compost, paper and sand (different layers are used to see the role of the worms in the soil)
4. Find some worms!! Try find up to 6 worms and place them in the plastic bottle on top of the different layers
5. Add a sprinkle of water and place the wormery into the shoebox standing upright (ensuring that it's dark)
6. Check on the wormery each week and observe what the worms have done to the layers
7. Ensure that the wormery is watered each week
